### Cayucos—A Chumash Canoe?

A reader has requested information on the origin of our fair town's name. It is believed to be an Indian word meaning "canoe".

The Chumash Indians were considered by some to be the most advanced of all California tribes, and were expert mariners. The tribal range extended from as far north as Estero point south to Santa Barbara and the Channel Islands.

The canoes were built mostly of driftwood, fitted, then sewn together with only sinew. The seams were caulked with asphaltum, naturally occurring beach tar. The canoes were usually 12-20 feet in length.

Another theory is that Cayucos is a Spanish rendering of the Eskimo word "kayak".


